

# JERSEY GAMBLING COMMISSION



## Report on Charitable Gambling Fees

With the introduction of the Gambling (Charitable and Membership Gambling) (Jersey) Regulations 2012, the Jersey Gambling Commission aimed to make charitable and social gambling an easier process to be undertaken by non-profit organisations. After review in 2019, the Commission decided to reduce the categories of permits from 4 to 2 and implement a modest increase. Fees for simple registrations remain unchanged.

After consultation the Jersey Gambling Commission has adopted the following fees:

Up to 3 times in one calendar year, prize pool not exceeding £1,500 per event.	Exempt	Exempt
Over 3 times in one calendar year or prize pool between £1,500 and £12,000 in one lottery event or £1,500 in one bingo event; but not exceeding an accumulated prize pool of £12,000 in bingo prizes or £30,000 lottery prizes in a calendar year.	£20.00	-
Any event exceeding a single prize pool of £12,000 or exceeding an accumulated prize pool of £30,000 (up to £500,000) per calendar year.		£175.00
Any event where the accumulated prize pool is over £500,000.		£550.00

### Amendment Fees

An amendment fee for a Permit is **£25**. An amendment usually concerns alterations such as a change of Promoter or an adjustment of the event's name; either scenario would require a physical revision of the actual Permit. There are no amendment fees for a Registration.

It should be noted that registrations are per calendar year, whereas a permit is per event. Once a registration is issued the society can run as many events as they have recorded on their schedule and have had approved by the Commission.
